

Educational Objectives

At the conclusion of the meeting, attendees should be able to:

- Interpret the current state-of-the-art knowledge in epidemiology, physiology and pathophysiology of female sexual function and dysfunction
- Assess female sexual dysfunction using history and physical, psychometrically validated inventories, blood tests, neurological and blood flow testing
- Apply medical, surgical, behavioral, and psychosocial treatments available for a woman with sexual dysfunction presenting in a community setting
- Distinguish when to treat a woman with sexual dysfunction in the office and when to refer her to a psychologist, physical therapist or sexual medicine physician
